Sketches of Three Y.W.A.P.A. Officers

A Few Words About the Young Women's Amateur Press Association

The officers of the short-lived Young Women's Amateur Press Association (Y.W.A.P.A.), as stated in Spencer's *The History of Amateur Journalism* (The Fossils, 1957) were as follows (p. 85):

President, Zelda Arlington Swift, Cincinnati, Ohio Vice-President, Helen G. Phillips, New Bedford, Mass. Secretary, Dora E. Sheldon, Rockford, Ill. Treasurer, Bertha York Grant, New Glasgow, Nova Scotia Official Editor, Edith May Dowe, Worcester, Mass.

Young women first attended the convention of the National Amateur Press Association in Boston in July 1885. However, a few months earlier, in February 1885, Zelda Arlington Swift had stated her opinion in her amateur magazine *Violet* (Spencer, p. 85): "We, the girls, should have an association of our own. It would be more interesting, and we could do better work as a body than we can singly." The Ladies Amateur Press Association was founded in August 1885, and was subsequently renamed the Young Women's Amateur Press Association. Zelda's magazine *Violet* published the official matter for Y.W.A.P.A. while the association lasted, which, according to Spencer, was only a little over a year.

Founding President Zelda Arlington Swift (1858-1904) (actual name Viola Frances Addison Swift) was covered in a feature article in THE FOSSIL for October 2020. Edith May (Dowe) Miniter (1867-1934) received coverage in THE FOSSIL for January 2021. Two collections of her literary works, *Dead Houses and Other Works* (2008) and *The Village Green and Other Pieces* (2013), have been published by Hippocampus Press. (The latter title contains a sketch of Mrs. Miniter and her works written by yours truly.) Her novel *Our Natupski Neighbors* (Henry Holt, 1916) is available online as well as from several reprint publishers.

In this column, I offer a few notes concerning the other three Y.W.A.P.A. officers.

Helen Gertrude Phillips (1868-1960), Vice President

Helen Gertrude Phillips was born to George R. Phillips (1831-1918) and Hannah S. Gray (1834-1899) in New Bedford, Massachusetts on July 29, 1868. Her paternal grandparents were William and Patience (Sowle) Phillips. Her maternal grandparents were Gilbert C. and Mary R. (Tripp) Gray. Her parents had married in New Bedford on March 7, 1854. Her father worked as a commission merchant. She had siblings Maria Eugenia Phillips (born 1858, Massachusetts), William Clifton Phillips (1870-1953), and Edith May Phillips (1873-1890). According to the 1940 census, Helen attended high school for two years. Her amateur magazines were Our Attempt and Le Sans Peur. The files of these two magazines at the American Antiquarian Society date from 1884-84 and 1885-87, respectively. Both were published in New Bedford.

Helen married February 14, 1894 (New Bedford) Charles Thomas Luce (born September 3, 1864, New Bedford), the son of Thomas Luce (1827-1911) and Hannah Butler Luce (1832-1879). Charles worked for his father Thomas Luce, a cooper and merchant. Thomas Luce had been born in the Azores Islands, and his wife in Falmouth, Massachusetts. Thomas Luce married (second) Lydia E. Payne (1839-1911). Charles Thomas Luce died in New Bedford in 1914. According to both the 1900 and 1910 censuses, Helen had not borne any children.

Helen's sister Maria Eugenia (Marie Eugenie) Phillips married September 4, 1888 (New Bedford) Edward J. Luce (born July 1858, New Bedford; died May 1934, New Jersey), the son of David Wing Luce (1827-1908) and Caroline Elizabeth Ewer (1831-1916). Edward and Maria resided in Rutherford, New Jersey, where Edward practiced law. They had a son Geoffrey Luce (born June 15, 1889, Rutherford, New Jesey; died July 27, 1890, New Bedford). The 1920 census enumerated Helen Luce with her brother-in-law and sister in Rutherford, New Jersey. Her surname was written as Fitzgerald, but then struck out. Maria Eugenia died in April 1929 in Bergen County, New Jersey. The 1930 census enumerated Edward J. Luce, age 71, with a new wife Elsie Anna (Gray) Luce, age 48, in Rutherford. Elsie Anna (Gray) Luce had been born in New Bedford on May 17, 1882, and died in Wayne Township, Passaic, New Jersey, on April 19, 1971.

Helen Luce lived at 32 Dean Street in Worcester, Massachusetts in 1927. By 1929, she had removed from Worcester to Rutherford to live with her sister and brother-in-law. According to the 1940 census, she was living in Rutherford on April 1, 1935. By 1940, she was living as a lodger in the home of George L. and Mazella P. (----) Hiller at 14 West William Street in Fairhaven, Massachusetts, just across the Acushnet River from her New Bedford birthplace. By 1945, she was living at 71 Center Street (Our Lady's Haven) in Fairhaven.

Helen was living at Our Lady's Haven when she slipped using her walker and broke her left hip in the infirmary on January 31, 1960. She died of bronchopneumonia thirteen days later, February 13, 1960. According to her death certificate she had resided in her place of residence for thirty-five years – this probably means in Fairhaven, rather than at Our Lady's Haven. She was buried in Oak Grove Cemetery in New Bedford on February 16, 1960.

Dora E. Sheldon (1868-1967), Secretary

Dora E. Sheldon was born on March 7, 1868, in Rockford, Illinois. Her father was Carlton W. Sheldon (1828-1914), the son of Gad Sheldon (1793-1875) and Eunice Hosford (1799-1872), who married in New York in 1820. Her mother was Harriet J. Hathaway (1835-1918), the daughter of Lemuel Wellington Hathaway (1809-1852) and Caroline Maria Thompson (1814-1898). Her mother Harriet was an 1854 graduate of the Rockford Female Seminary. Her parents married on December 20, 1855 in Winnebago Co., Illinois. Her paternal grandmother Eunice Hosford was the daughter of Joseph Hosford (1761-1847), a Revolutionary War veteran, and his wife Mary Williams (1767-1840). Lemuel W. Hathaway and Caroline Maria Thompson had married in 1831 in Grafton, Massachusetts. Lemuel worked as a shoemaker. He was the son of Warren Hathaway and Jemima Dudley, born in Sutton, Massachusetts.

In addition to Dora, Carlton W. and Harriet J. Sheldon had children (all born in Illinois): Charles E. Sheldon (born 1857), George Proctor Sheldon (1859-1934), Edgar L. Sheldon (1861-1862), Edna A. Sheldon (1872-1874), and Ethel Alice Sheldon (born 1878). Carlton W. Sheldon was an attorney. He and his wife and their children Edgar, Edna, and George are all buried in Cedar Bluff Cemetery in Rockford.

The family was living at 514 North 2nd Street in Rockford when the 1880 census was enumerated. Dora,

age 12, was in school, while her brother Charles E., age 23, worked as a fire insurance agent. Dora married June 14, 1892 (Winnebago County, Illinois) George Strong Hart (1866-1917), the son of John Warren Hart (1838-1920) and Elsie Ann Tuttle (1833-1920). However, the 1900 census found her back in her parents' household at 530 North 2nd Street in Rockford. She had been married for eight years and had not borne any children. In the same census, her husband George S. Hart, age 33, was enumerated as a prisoner in the Illinois State Penitentiary in Joliet, Illinois. (The November 18, 1899 Freeport Daily Bulletin reported, "George S. Hart, formerly a clerk in the Rockford Insurance company office, who forged checks for over \$1,000 last December and ran away, was caught at Carthage, Mo., vesterday and will be brought back for trial.") In 1910, George Hart was enumerated with his parents in Ward 35 of Chicago. Both George and his father worked as accountants. George, age 49, born in Michigan of a New York-born father and a Pennsylvania-born mother, stated his marital condition as divorced. George Hart and his parents are buried in Silverbrook Cemetery in Niles, Berrien County, Michigan.

Dora married (second) July 6, 1907 (Aberdeen, Washington) John Bainbridge Benson (born May 13, 1878, Vermont; died October 5, 1943, Aberdeen, Washington), the son of Bainbridge C. Benson and Mary Lutheria (Williams) Benson. Dora and her husband were enumerated in Aberdeen in the 1910, 1920, 1930 and 1940 censuses. In 1910, John Benson owned a clothing store, while in 1920 he owned a stationery store, and in 1930 and 1940 an office equipment store. John's niece Pearl Bernice Slade (born March 6, 1906, Winhall, Vermont; died March 7, 1991, Aberdeen, Washington) lived with the family in 1920 and 1930. She worked as a saleslady in John's office equipment store in 1930. She married Donald Francis Murchison (born 1907), the son of Kenneth R. Murchison and Irene Vincent, on February 28, 1932, in Aberdeen.

Dora survived her period of activity in Y.W.A.P.A. by more than eighty years. She died in Hoquiam, Washington, on August 25, 1967 at the age of ninetynine. She and her second husband and his parents are all buried in Fern Hill Cemetery in Aberdeen, Washington. Her date of birth was misstated as March 7, 1885 in her cemetery record, and as March 1869 in the 1900 census.

Bertha York Grant (1863-1945), Treasurer

Bertha Selina York was born in Lewiston, Maine, on February 7, 1863, the daughter of Jerome Wallace York (1831-1895) and Martha Jane Read (1844-1905). According to an Ancestry Family Tree, her lineage was Bertha Selina(8) [Jerome Wallace(7) Abraham Russell(6) Peter(5) John (4-3) Abraham(2) John(1)] originating with Maine-born John(1) York in 1690. Her father had married Betsey J. Brooks (1838-1860) as his first wife. Bertha had half-sibling Ordelbert York (1860-1935) and full siblings Lemuel Adolphus York (1866-1957), Guy A. York (1867-1874), Frank Goodwin York (1869-1932) and Conn Read York (1872-1873).

Bertha married (first) August 24, 1878 (Concord, New Hampshire) Orlando Vincent Johnson (born July 4, 1855, Quincy, Massachusetts; died September 30, 1923, Boston), the son of Joseph Glover Johnson (1822-1879) and Lovilla Equilla Woodman (1828-1904). Her first husband was a printer, and the couple resided in Concord when the 1880 census was enumerated. After their divorce, Orlando married (second) April 1, 1892 (Boston) Mary Smith (1868-1906).

Bertha was one of the first five women to attend a National Amateur Press Association convention in Boston in July 1885. On the first day of the convention, she married (second) July 15, 1885 in Melrose, Massachusetts Finlay Arnon Grant (born August 12, 1862, Sunny Brae, Pictou County, Nova Scotia; died May 2, 1897, Fargo, North Dakota), the son of Alexander Grant (1829-1913) and Annie MacDonald (1843-1917). Finlay had printed Bertha's first volume of poetry, *Only Buds*, from New Glasgow the prior year. The couple had a son Arnon York Grant, born February 13, 1892, in Fargo, North Dakota. Bertha and her husband attended the NAPA convention in Chicago in 1893. The 1900 census enumerated the widowed Bertha, age 37, working as a stenographer, with her son Arlo [sic] Grant, age 9, at 1437 3rd Avenue in Fargo. Bertha stated that she had borne two children, of whom one was living. Her husband Finlay Arnon Grant was buried in Riverside Cemetery in New Glasgow.

Bertha married (third) August 15, 1903 in Fargo, North Dakota Edward Willis Avery (born June 3, 1862, Perrysville, Indiana; died August 5, 1936, Los Angeles), the son of William Hugh Avery (1838-1925) and Clarissa Jane Waggaman (1842-1930). Avery had married (first) Alla Barr (born 1863, Goderich, Ontario; died 1890 near Gilead, Nebraska), by whom he had a son Ivan Hugh Avery (born August 4, 1887, Reynolds, Nebraska; died 1955). The 1920 census enumerated Edward Avery, a salesman of educational books, and his wife in Anoka, Minnesota. The 1930 census enumerated the couple in Crookston, Minnesota, where Avery was working as an instructor. In addition to themselves, they had five lodgers in their household. In 1933, Edwin B. Hill printed Bertha's poetry collection Dream Haven from Ysleta, Texas.

After the death of her third husband, Bertha entered the Masonic Home for the Aged in Bloomington, Minnesota, where she was enumerated in the 1940 census. Bertha's son Arnon died in San Francisco on August 30, 1945. His mother followed him in death in Bloomington, Minnesota on December 27, 1945.

Bertha York Grant

[Bertha's eight page entry in the 1891 Literary Cyclopedia of Amateur Journalism includes several of her poems and



sketches. The book is dedicated to "Mr. and Mrs. Finlay Arnon Grant, in whom are united those qualities which make up the author's ideal of a true amateur journalist." Her picture is the most prominent of nine authors.]

Miss Bertha S. York contributed her first sketch to amateur journalism in 1881, but did not become generally known in its literature until a year

later. At this time she contributed under various names, including "Topsy," "Rose Leaf," "Pansy," and "Galatea," but her principal works were signed "Bertha." In 1885 she was made recording secretary of the national association, and in that year she became the wife of Mr. Finlay A. Grant, an ex-president of the association. During that year she was one of the editors of the *American Sphinx*. In 1890 she published a paper called *Pansies*. Her poetry was notable for its charms of expression, its fine sentiment, its loving sweetness, and its beautiful imagery. It was said of some of it, and no doubt with truth, that it was obscure. This seemed to result not from design, nor from an ill-defined idea in the author's brain, but from the fact that what she so clearly and forcibly saw herself she fancied others could perceive as well, and consequently left some of her poems rather vague. Her technique was not always perfect, but her soul, which found expression in her spontaneous and sincere outbursts of song, was that of the true poet. Her poems evidently came from the heart and went to the heart. ...

As a sketch writer Mrs. Grant had a style peculiarly her own. As a delineator of pathetic phases of character she had no equal. There ran through all her work a seriousness, even a sadness, but it was not morbid; her stories were not gloomy, but were full of a touching sweetness, a tenderness, and an earnest sympathy. Her descriptions of scenery were vivid and very powerful, and her treatment of this portion of her sketches essentially poetic. Her plots were not strikingly original, but were developed in a manner essentially her own. The plane of her stories was high, and her sentiment of the purest tone. Many of her poems and sketches were published in book form in 1883, by Mr. Grant, under the title, "Only Buds." ... Y.W.A.P.A. had a small balance in its treasury when it ceased to exist in 1886. For many years, Bertha, who had been treasurer, worried over how to dispose of this balance. Finally, after the death of Y.W.A.P.A.'s former president Zelda Arlington Swift in 1904, Bertha hit upon the perfect solution: the remaining balance was used to place violets on the former president's grave.

Y.W.A.P.A. - In Conclusion

If anyone has access to a full roster of Y.W.A.P.A., I would be very grateful for a copy. If granted this boon, I would probably be inspired to research additional sketches of members.

Writing on "Women in Amateurdom" in the *Women's Representative* section of *Violet* for February 1886, Edith Dowe mentioned two magazines conducted by members of Y.W.A.P.A. The first was the *Quartette*, edited by Miss G[racia] A. Smith and three associates

[Bertha joined The Fossils in 1939 and remained a member until her death. Her obituary ran in the April 1946 Fossil.]

THE PASSING of an amateur of the Golden Era may mean little to the amateur journalists of today, but members of The Fossils will recall with more than momentary interest the death of one who was prominent in amateur journalism as poet and sketch writer, commencing in 1882. ...

During the New York convention of the National Amateur Press Association in 1885, Miss York was married to Finlay A. Grant, former president of the National. ... Mr. Grant followed the printer's craft. After his death, Mrs. Grant married again and has been known to amateurs of this generation as Bertha Grant Avery. Her home became Cass Lake, Minnesota, where she devoted her days to designing, under the name Pierrot Studios. Her work was artistic and won for her high place in the estimation of her limited clientele.

Her first book, *Only Buds*, consisted of poems and sketches. It was published in 1884. Her last book, *Dream Haven*, verses solely, was published in 1933 in an edition of 100 copies.

When Mrs. Grant disposed of her home at Cass Lake, "Dream Haven," she entered the Masonic Home at Minneapolis, Minnesota. Here she continued her work in designing, writing occasional verse, and always interesting letters to her friends. Her health gradually failed, but until almost the last she was able to carry out her plans for further literary work. Finally, however, more serious illness intervened, and she was helpless. The end, a relief from a busy and not wholly happy life, occurred in December 1945.

(Mabel F. Noyes, Jennie M. Day and Lottie Smith), from Springfield, Massachusetts. The second was *Duett*, edited by Jennie Day and Frances A. Parsons, from Westfield, Massachusetts. In the same column, she complained of the silence of "Bertha" (Bertha S. York Grant) and the Woodzelle sisters. Note that Gracia Smith was one of the "girls of eighty-five"; she married a Mr. Woffenden (who worked in the post office) and they both died young. In the same section of *Violet* for June 1886, Miss Dowe wrote:

Since last July I have prepared Ms. for the Y.Wapa Dep't of the *Violet*, on such subjects which I endeavored to make interesting to the feminine element of the 'dom alone. It has been my intention to cover the field of amateurdom solely as concerned the girls and their work, so far as was compatible in the space allowed. This, so far as I know, was and is the only duty of the Official Editor of the Association.

With best wishes for the Asso's good. EDITH MAY DOWE, Official Editor Y.Wapa, Term 1885-86.

After her own marriage to John T. F. Miniter (1864?-1900) in September 1887, the young couple undertook the publication of the weekly newspaper *The Worcester County News* from Webster, Massachusetts. In November 1887, they issued what proved to be a one-shot amateur paper, *The Webster Amateur*, using the presses of their weekly newspaper. It contained a column titled "Questions":

Y.W.A.P.A.

Where is it?

Has it entered oblivion with Zelda Swift's correspondence?

Why were there no election returns received?

There was a convention announced for the time of the Napa meeting.

There was a solitary lady at Philadelphia. Did she hold the Ywapa gathering?

Why do we young women allow the sequel of our association to show that "Girls can't run business alone nohow"? Did Dennie Sullivan print our paper? If he did, where is it? What does he say? That he sent it to the editor of this paper. But she never saw it.

Is the Y.W.A.P.A. to die? If so, why not give it a decent funeral? If not, why not rouse it from sleep, wash its face, sweep off the cobwebs, and send it out on some business? Zelda Swift, Helen Phillips, Zebbie Hunt, please answer p.q. [Author's note: p.q. probably means "*¿por qué*" or "why?"]

If Mrs. Miniter ever received answers concerning Y.W.A.P.A.'s fate, she does not seem to have published them. Making ends meet with the Miniters' own weekly newspaper soon plunged her into her own silent period. Y.W.A.P.A. was left to fade into oblivion.

I have a few notes on Frances A. Parsons, Jennie M. Day, and the Woodzelle sisters that I may inflict upon readers in a future column. But I'd still like to get hold of a full membership list for Y.W.A.P.A., if one can be found. I suggest Zelda Swift's *Violet* as a starting point.





It is deemed advisable to begin early in order that the arrangements may be perfect in every detail before convention time Respectfully.

MILWAUKEE PRESSLITERARY CLUB including regular membership meetings, a May Party, and a Dancing Social organized by the Milwaukee Press Literary Club (later Association). That organization aspired late in the 19th century to restore Milwaukee's status as "the banner city of amateurdom." Enthusiasts in towns like Beloit, Burlington, Elroy, Fennimore, Fond du Lac, La Crosse, Neemah, Oshkosh, and Wauwatosa, also waved the AJ banner in this period.

Thanks to student work supported by the generosity of the Leland M. Hawes, Jr. Fund for the Library of Amateur Journalism, we were also able to locate additional evidence of Wisconsin AJ enthusiasm from among the thousands of loose issues collected by Willametta and Martin Keffer: witness, for example, The Badger, Badger Scratches, Badger Spotlight, The Badger State Amateur Journalist, and The Badgerweed. We reported to you in January 2023 that our students had sorted more than 78 cartons of individual AJ issues alphabetically by title and that the next phase of the project, producing a folder list, had

begun. The student working on the folder list has since made substantial progress and is now up to the N's: the result is a spreadsheet currently listing some 3300 titles, some represented by only one issue, some represented by extensive runs. Once this title listing is enhanced with names, places, and date ranges, it will not only allow researchers quickly to zero in on specific titles, but will also help map the long-running and wide-ranging enterprise of amateur journalism as reflected in the LAJ Collection.

Hawes Fund Provides \$1K in LAJ Support During 2022

THE 2022 Financial Statement from the Wisconsin Foundation & Alumni Association reports the Leland M. Hawes, Jr. Fund for the Library of Amateur Journalism provided \$1,103.50 of financial support for the LAJ during 2022, despite a down market that caused the value of the overall endowment funds to drop by 15.1%. The Fund has dispensed \$5,400.24 in support since its inception in 2016.

The Hawes Fund received \$300 in donations during 2022, and ended the year with a market value of \$23,698.24.

Official Editor's Message

Who Should Become a Fossil?

WHAT ARE the requirements for becoming a Fossil? When the group was founded in 1904 as a way for the old boys from the Golden Age of amateurdom to stay in contact, the answer was clear: activity in amateur journalism before 1890. From the beginning, the term amateur journalism was not synonymous with the mainstream ajay amateur press associations (National, United, and American), but could be personal publishing of any kind.

In the 1930s and '40s the activity requirement was liberalized several times until it mandated activity at least fifteen years before joining. In 1970, when The Fossils rebranded itself as the Historians of Amateur Journalism, the time was shortened to three years. Eventually even that qualification was dropped and the only requirement for membership was an interest in the history of our hobby.

Subscriptions to THE FOSSIL were originally offered for those who wanted to read the articles but did not yet qualify for membership. We still provide subscriptions, although the difference between a member and subscriber is much narrower these days (particularly since we have not held an election since 2010).

To some extent, it's surprising we get any new subscribers or members at all since our only product, THE FOSSIL, is available online for free. When we started our website in 2005, then-president Guy Miller felt it more important to share our information than to receive money for it. We do appreciate all of you who pay the price — and even more so those who make an extra donation — to financially support our efforts to publish articles on ajay history.

These thoughts come to mind thanks to Mick Taylor, who began subscribing to THE FOSSIL last year. In January I wrote to ask about his connection to the hobby, and he promptly replied:

I'm interested in amateur journalism, from a few angles. Perhaps predictably, one of them is Lovecraft and his involvement in the hobby. But at the same time I got interested in the zine movement of the period, being briefly a member of S. T. Joshi's Esoteric Order of Dagon and contributing to a few esoterically oriented zines that friends produced. The zine world gave me much pleasure, and I formed some lasting friendships.

More recently I have become very interested in small, local, detailed histories, such as Ken Faig's *Lovecraftian People and Places*. This led me to read older copies of THE FOSSIL and I became fascinated with the stories of the amateur journalists of bygone years. I've enjoyed every issue that I've read; it's all right up my alley.

When his subscription renewal was mailed, I added a note that he could upgrade to full membership for only \$5 more. Secretary-Treasurer Tom Parson reported that a check for \$15 came through, but when I checked back with Mick he had decided to make it a \$10 subscription plus \$5 donation.

I worry that by taking full membership I would be claiming status as an amateur journalist inappropriately. I've never been a member of either of the major amateur journalism organizations, and, while I am currently a member of the Esoteric Order of Dagon APA, I've so far produced a grand total of one zine.

President Ken Faig replied to Mick, "One zine doth an amateur journalist make...although I don't think it's an old saying. In any case, we appreciate your support, whatever category (subscriber or member) that you choose."

Microsoft's AI-powered chatbot adds, "Joining The Fossils would be an excellent opportunity for those interested in preserving the history of independent publishing and amateur journalism."

Kelsey on Babcock and Bradofsky

Matthew Kelsey joined the American Amateur Press Association as a pre-teen boy printer in 1973. He soon was attending meetings of the Southern Californian group NAPA West and also NAPA conventions held in the area. The review in the last issue of the book containing letters H. P. Lovecraft sent to Hyman Bradofsky and Ralph Babcock sparked a comment from Matt:

I met Hyman Bradofsky in the 1970s as part of NAPA West meetings. He was kind to me and gave me copies of his old journals and other publications. He was obviously a fastidious man, still wearing a suit to those informal meetings, and I could see the reasons for bad blood with a young Ralph Babcock, who I also met and visited in the late 70s. Good memories of two good men. Lovecraft was correct in his assessment of RB's potential.

I reminded Matt that he had ties to a third Fossil mentioned in the book: Jack Bond, whom Matt once disapproved for an AAPA office. I happened to visit Florida around that time, and heard Jack complain about the comments made by "young Kelsey." Matt's response:

It's embarrassing to think of a few of the comments I printed, even with the slow reflective process of setting them in type! Partly I blame Ralph Babcock and the influence of reading his earlier journals with their own inflammatory comments. :-) Mixed in of course with his amazing typography and use of the latest European faces, and his own glib but well honed style of writing. I guess his work was my ideal of what I should aspire to do, for a time.

Matt and his wife Julie live in Saratoga, California, where he runs his own high-quality letterpress design studio. He is also a leading light in the San Jose Printers' Guild.

The most recent Fossil fiscal year ran from August 15, 2022 to August 14, 2023. During that time, income totaled \$402 and expenses \$725.36:



With 19 paid single and 3 joint memberships, total dues were expected to be \$345 (\$60 above receipts), but some late payments this year and prepayments in earlier years reduced the total. Bank fees rose by 50% compared to the previous year.

There were 44 total pages in volume 119, the same as volume 118, but printing costs rose by 66%. The cost of printing and mailing one copy of each of the four issues in the volume was \$22.43.

One Fossil, Jack Scott, chose to let his membership expire and two Fossils, Robert Lichtman and Kent Clair Chamberlain died.

Over half of the renewing members and subscribers made donations ranging from \$2 to \$15. Many thanks to those who help cover our increasing costs.



The Fossils' bank balance has fluctuated between \$3,600 and \$4,400 since 2015.

All-Time Fossils' "In Memoriam" List

THE PROJECT to update The Fossils' In Memoriam list has grown! The July issue described the listing of Fossils who had died that was periodically updated and published in THE FOSSIL beginning in 1911. It had grown to 265 names when it was printed for the final time in the June 1943 issue. In the last issue I described the process for correcting and resorting it into alphabetical order.

That 1943 issue also included a membership list with 157 names. Ken Faig used online genealogy resources to look up death dates for each person in that list. I followed up by finding obituaries in old issues of The Fossil, and using additional genealogy records to verify birth and death dates. After that work was completed, I reviewed all issues since 1943 to identify obituaries of additional members and to identify any Fossil officer who did not have an obituary. The resulting list of 661 Fossils who died between 1905 and 2022 is published below.

I admit the list is not an exhaustive compilation of anyone who ever was a Fossil. It misses any early Fossils who were not on the 1943 lists, or who joined after 1943 and neither served as an officer nor had an obituary printed. Certainly there are a number of missing Fossils whose connection to the organization was short-lived, but I believe this list captures all prominent Fossils. If you notice any omission, send me the name(s) and I will attempt an update.



Working through the names, I identified two who should have been on the 1943 list: Henry L. Bryan, who was president in 1918-19, died in 1934 but somehow was not added to the In Memoriam list. Wilbur C. Brown died in 1941 after losing contact with the group; he was still listed as a member in 1943 and his name was quietly dropped a few years later.

The birth years of those on the alltime list range from 1847 (Thomas A. Edison) to 1963 (Daniel Graham), but I was surprised that the average birth year remained firmly in the nineteenth century: the mean and median for birth year are both 1869. Perhaps this indicates the large size of the community of those original amateur journalists compared to their later brethren. The average age at death is 76. Six Fossils have lived beyond their 100th birthday: Louise A. Lincoln, John J. Apatow, Charles H. Bloomer, Jr., James Larkin Pearson, Martha E. Shivvers, and Marion Fields Wyllie. Eighty Fossils have died since the year 2000, with an average age at death of 85.7.

I kept track of my work using a spreadsheet that records the names, birth dates, death dates, and dates of obituaries in The Fossil. I am happy to share it with any interested parties who contact me.

The online version of this issue at www.thefossils.org/fossil contains the list resorted in chronological order by death as pages 13-16. It is sobering to move from names of those who are long-past to familiar friends.
